VALIDITY & LEGALITY

The school may be referred to as TALK International, TALK, The Language Institute or TLI in this Program & Application for Admission.

The Fees and Terms and Conditions published apply to all courses starting during 2010 and are valid from August 31st, 2009. They supersede all previous terms and conditions and are subject to the law of the State of Florida and only this English version is legally binding.

VISAS

TALK is authorized by the Federal Government to enroll non-immigrant students. Eligible students are required to attend programs of 20 units (18 clock hours) or more per week.

Eligible students are required to prove financial responsibility, and therefore must provide TALK with either a bank statement or bank letter, or a letter of financial support from a company or sponsor.

F-1 visa applicants are required by Immigrations & Customs Enforcement to pay a one-time fee (currently \$200). The SEVIS fee is paid directly to ICE via the Internet or mail.

HOW TO APPLY

Students (or their parent or legal guardian if under the age of 18) must complete and sign the Application for Admission and provide it to the local TALK representative with the Application Fee of US \$150.00.

If there is no TALK representative, students should fax or e-mail the Application for Admission and Application Fee to TALK (with payment by credit card or wire transfer as shown under "Method of Payment" below).

COURSE CONFIRMATION

TALK will send written Application Acknowledgement, Course Confirmation and Invoice, within five working days of receiving the student's Application for Admission and Application Fee. TALK will send written confirmation of accommodation details and airport transfer information as soon as it is available.

In the unlikely event that TALK does not accept the student's application, all money paid by the student will be refunded in full.

COURSE PAYMENT

TALK will invoice the student for tuition and accommodation. This invoice must be paid no less than 2 weeks prior to the course start date. Fees are calculated in complete weeks and part of a week is counted as a full week.

METHODS OF PAYMENT

UNITS

Each unit equals 45 minutes of teaching. Typically breaks are taken after 2 consecutive units of teaching.

REFUNDS PRIOR TO START DATES

All fees paid except the Application Fee, Examination, Insurance and Express Courier Fees paid on behalf of the student will be refunded in full, provided that cancellation is received prior to the course or accommodations start date, or because of visa denial.

TUITION REFUNDS AFTER START DATE

Students must provide notification of withdrawal IN WRITING at least 2 weeks prior to the withdrawal date, with the final class being a Friday. Students enrolled for 4 weeks or less will not be eligible for a refund. Students enrolled for periods of 5 weeks or more and who withdraw prior to the midpoint of their studies will be eligible for a refund of the prorated amount of the unused portion of tuition (after the notification period). Students withdrawing from their program after the midpoint are not eligible to receive any refund. TALK is not obligated to make refunds to students who are terminated due to violation of written disciplinary and/or attendance policies or local state or federal law.

ACCOMMODATIONS REFUNDS AFTER START DATE

Student understands and accepts that TALK acts strictly as an agent for the student; that TALK may contract in its own name to facilitate the booking process based upon the students' requirements as indicated in this Application Form and that TALK is entitled to difference between what the provider charges and the student pays, as a commission. Students enrolled for 4 weeks or less will not be eligible for a refund. All requests to cancel, change or leave accommodations must be made in writing and provided to TALK at least 4 weeks prior to the proposed change, which shall occur on a Saturday. The accommodation fee will be based upon the applicable accommodation rate for the length of stay at the time of termination and not on the prorated rate of long-term accommodation.

Students utilizing on Campus Residence or housing are bound by the terms and conditions of that agreement. The University Residence Placement Fee is non-refundable.

REFUNDS

Refunds are made to the student who cancels prior to the first scheduled class date within 30 days of that date. Refunds are made to students who cancel after the start date within 30 days of their last class.

MINIMUM AGE

The minimum age for participation in TALK courses is 16 years. There is no upper age limit.

INSURANCE

It is student's responsibility to research and evaluate the policy referred by TALK. TALK has no expertise in such matters and will facilitate the insurance for students only if the request is received in writing with the Application Form and the non-refundable payment is received in full prior to commencement of classes.

SCHOOL RULES

TALK publishes School Rules and Regulations to help maintain the highest standards in its programs. Acceptance of and compliance with these rules and regulations and with all appropriate federal and state laws are contractual obligations on the part of the student. Failure to comply with any of these rules may result in termination of the program and/or withholding of course certificates.

MINIMUM GROUP SIZE & CONVERSION

In the event that a group class has less than 4 students, TALK, at its option, may convert 3 group classes to 1 semi-private class (2 or 3 students) or 4 group classes to 1 private session.
